NOTICE OF RACE
LAKE COILA 2009 SERIES II

1. RULES

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Yachting Australia and its Special Regulations, Part 2 For Off the Beach Boats will apply.
- 1.3. Rules will be changed 32 33 35 63.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The series is open to an off the beach boat other than a sailboard.
- 2.2 An eligible boat may enter:
 - (a) the series, by completing the attached form and submitting it together with the required fee to the Race Officer prior to the first race in the series; or
 - (b) a race in the series, by completing the attached form and submitting it together with the required fee to the Race Officer prior to the race.

3. FEES

- 5.1 No fee is required to be paid by a member of the Batemans Bay Sailing Club Inc (the Club) or another club affiliated to a Member Yachting Association.

4. SCHEDULE

Registration

- 4.1 Registration shall be on Sunday 11.01.09 from 1100 hours to 1200 hours.

Dates of racing

Races 1 and 2: Sunday, 11.01.09. Races 3 and 4: Sunday 25.01.09.

Race 5: Sunday 08.02.09. Races 6 and 7: Sunday 22.02.09.

Race 8: Sunday 08.03.09. Races 9 and 10: Sunday 22.03.09.

Race 11: Sunday 05.04.09. Races 12 and 13: Sunday 19.04.09.

4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1230 hours.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be available from the Race Officer on Sunday 11.01.09 at 1100 hours.

6. VENUE

6.1 The series will be conducted on Coila Lake from in front of the Tuross Sports and Recreation Complex, Coila Lake. Attachment A shows the location of the series and the racing areas.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The diagrams in Attachment B show the courses.

8. SCORING

8.1 The Bonus Point System of Appendix A will apply.

8.2 All races that are started and not abandoned constitute the series.

8.3 (a) When fewer than 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 10 to 11 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 to 13 have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

9 HANDICAP SYSTEM

Batemans Bay Sailing Club Inc. Performance Handicapping [PHS] appears on its website.

10 PRIZES

10.1 A prize will be given to the first, second and third boat in each division.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after a race in the series.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event or the equivalent.
