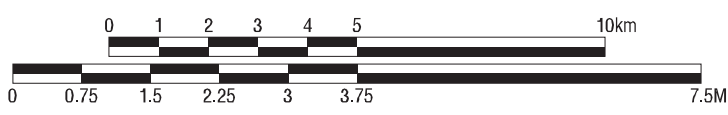


Batemans Bay Coastal Area - Map 12

Note: It is compulsory to carry certain safety equipment, including a lifejacket Type 1 for all on board, whilst navigating in the open sea. It is also compulsory that lifejackets be worn whilst crossing most entrance bars shown on this map.

The Boating (Safety Equipment) Regulation NSW, requires that when vessels are on open waters, that is out from the coast, they must carry an appropriate map or chart.
In the interests of safe boating, this map is deemed to be an appropriate map for use by recreational vessels undertaking voyages less than 3 nautical miles off the coast and within a radius of 15 nautical miles of their point of departure from the coast.
Vessels undertaking longer voyages than that stated above MUST carry an appropriate chart, which is an Admiralty or Australian Hydrographic Chart showing the area proposed for the vessels voyage or excursion.
It is the responsibility of the user to ensure that they are in the possession of the latest map. When using this map on unfamiliar waters, check with NSW Maritime to determine if it is the latest issued.
